

Dear Mrs. Swiryn:


Your letter of 16 December 1944, addressed to the Commanding Officer of the organization to which your son, Private Herschel Swiryn belonged, has been forwarded to this office for reply.

The great anxiety you have suffered since your son has been reported missing in action is most understandable and, realizing your desire to know the circumstances under which he has been reported missing, I wish to advise you that an additional report has been received in the War Department. This report states that on 26 November 1944 the company of which Private Swiryn was a member, was attacking enemy positions near Eischweiler, Germany. When the objective was reached and the company reorganized, your son was missing, and although a thorough search was made over the area he was not found.

I again wish to assure you that at any time additional information is received, it will be transmitted to you without delay.

Permit me to extend my continued sympathy in your anxiety.
