22. RO Gps E733-1, E733-2, E733-3, E733-4, E733-5, E733-6, E733-7, E733-8, E733-9, E733-10, E733-11, E733-12, E733-13, E733-14, E733-15, E733-16, E733-18, E733-19, E733-20, E733-21 and E733-22, WP by first available water trans fr pres overseas sta to a recp sta in the US, to be named by atchd to this order by the Commander of the US Port at which the gp is debarked.

23. This movement constitutes a perm change of sta for ea individual with TDY enroute, at a US port, recp sta, and redistribution sta. The latter will designate the new perm sta of ea individual.

24. Gps named in Par 22 will be under the control of the CG, ASF, fr time of departure fr overseas sta until released by proper authority in the US.

25. Equip proscribed in Cir 43, Hq European TO, USA, dtd 19 Apr 1945, will be carried.

26. Records listed in Par 15 of WD Ltr, AG 370.5 (10 Aug 1944) OB-S-SPMOT-II, subject: "Procedure for Return of Individuals", dtd 16 Aug 1944, as amended by Supplements No. 1, 2 and 3, will be carried whenever possible by the person in charge of the gp and will be delivered to the CO upon arrival at destination.

27. LT COL EUGENE CLARK, 0361722, AC, of RO Gp E733-21 is designated Officer in charge of RO Gps E733-1, E733-2, E733-3, E733-4, E733-5, E733-6, E733-7, E733-8, E733-9, E733-10, E733-11, E733-12, E733-13, E733-14, E733-15, E733-16, E733-18, E733-19, E733-20, E733-21 and E733-22.

28. Correspondents and publishers will be notified to discontinue mailing letters and publications until they receive notification of new address. V-Mail notice to correspondents and publishers WD AGO Form No. 971-1, 9 Oct 1 43, may be used for this purpose.

29. Info concerning the WD, Army or personal activities of a mil nature within this theater will not be discussed in private or public, and will not be disclosed by means of newspapers, magazines, books, lectures or radio, or any other method without prior clearance through the WD Bureau of Public Relations or the appropriate Public Relations Office of Army Installations.

30. Attention is invited to classified Ltr, Hq European TO, USA, 16 Sep 1943, file AG 311.4, relative to clearance through the customs on leaving and entering the US.

31. Attention is invited to Ltr, WD, Adjutant General's Office, file AG 524 (18 Aug 1944) OB-S-SPMOT-II, subject: "Processing of Baggage from Overseas", dtd 29 Aug 1944, and amendments thereto which must be complied with by all personnel prior to arriving at UK Ports for shipment to the US. Copies of letter and explanation of the procedure to be followed may be secured from any US RTO in the UK.
